A ton of coal weighs 2,000 pounds. Delivered in sacks, there should be 20 sacks of 100 pounds each.

Coal should be delivered to your bins without making any dirt, because it should be carefully screened before sacking.

Lump coal should be used for heating purposes, because a large lump will hold fire longer than small coal.

Nut or egg size coal should be used in the kitchen range, because it is uniform in size, and does not have to be broken up in your basement, making a lot of dirt and fine stuff too fine to keep from falling through the grates.
