Sharp) In agricultural districts in various parts of England teams of "Morris Men" decked out with jingling bells and other finery, can still be seen dancing to "Shepherd's Hey" and other tra-ditional dance tunes played on the fiddle or on the "pipe and tabor" (a sort of drum and fife).
