

ITINERARY for JUNE 1

- 9:30 A. M. Vice-President Fairbanks and President Goode will be conducted by an escort of Cavalry from Mr. Goode's residence to point where parade forms near Portland Hotel.
- 9:45 A. M. Committee of Twenty Directors escort Congressional Committee, Governors, et. al. from Portland Hotel in carriages to point where parade forms.
- 10:00 A. M. Parade starts from point near Portland Hotel and marches into Exposition grounds through the 28th Street and Thurman Avenue entrance, and thence along St. Helens Road to the New York State Building where they should arrive about 11:30 A. M.
The Cavalry and Infantry, with bands, then march to positions assigned them in vicinity of the Ceremonial Platform by the Grand Marshal, while the Artillery follows "The Trail" and crosses the "Bridges of Nations" to the Peninsula where it prepares to fire salutes when signalled.
- 10:30 A. M. Committee of Three Directors escort ladies of Congressional Party in carriages to President Goode's residence at 20th and Flanders streets, where they call for Mrs. Fairbanks and Mrs. Goode and escort them direct to Exposition grounds via 28th street and Thurman Avenue entrance; thence to reserved seats on the ground in front of the Ceremonial Platform.
- 11:45 A. M. The Vice-President, Congressional Committee and other male guests walk from the New York Building to the Ceremonial Platform.
- 12 NOON THE OPENING CEREMONIES COMMENCE
- 1:30 P. M. The Opening Ceremonies conclude and the official guests repair to the New York Building for refreshments.
- 7 P. M. Dinner at the New York Building in honor of the Vice-President and Congressional Committee by the Exposition Directorate.
- 9 -- 11 P. M. Reception follows in Pavilion Annex to New York Building.
