Design of MEDAL, to have any corrections or alterations you desire to make, herewith forwarded to you.

We are prepared to go to work immediately and can deliver the MEDALS in ninety (90) days from date hereof; or, for a bonus of \$250.00 to cover the extra cost of operating nights, we will undertake to deliver in 60 days; said bonus not to be paid unless shipment is made within 60 days from the date of your acceptance.
