






### PARADES

Three great parades ... each entirely different from the others ... enliven Rose Festival week. The comic Merrykhana parade, dedicated to fun and laughter, will launch Rose Festival activities June 7. On June 10, the unusual Junior Rose Festival Parade will see more than 10,000 youngsters taking part in their own colorful pageant. And the Grand Floral Parade June 11 will draw more than a half million spectators.

### CORONATION OF THE QUEEN

Eleven beautiful girls, chosen by their fellow students from Portland high schools, will vie in elaborate ceremonies for the honor of ruling over the Realm of Rosaria for the ensuing year.

### STADIUM SHOWS

Dramatic, eye-catching events will be scheduled in Portland's great Multnomah Stadium to provide evening entertainment for thousands of Rose Festival visitors.

### FESTIVAL CENTER

Proved to be an outstanding Rose Festival attraction after two years of successful operation, the Festival Center will be moved to the site of Portland's great Holladay Park for the 1960 Festival. Fundides, exhibits, outdoor stage shows, souvenir booths, refreshment stands, midway features offer continuous entertainment during Rose Festival week.

### **ROSE SHOW/MARINE DAY**

One of the nation's oldest and best-known rose shows draws exhibitors from every state.

Water sports, boat racing, water skiing are offered as a closing Festival highlight.


